Department of Health Information Release #3 MBS Chemotherapeutic Procedures

On 1 November 2020, the structure to chemotherapeutic procedures listed on the Medicare Benefits Schedule (MBS) will change. These changes result from the recommendations of the <u>MBS</u> <u>Review Taskforce Oncology Clinical Committee Report 2018</u> (publically available at <u>www.health.gov.au</u>), and progressive liaison between the Department of Health and peak professional bodies.
